Re: Water Service Disruption

Dear Water Customer:

The Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority's (RWSA) Wholesale Metering Program has created the need to schedule a temporary water shutdown of the water main serving your property. The existing water main runs along Stribling Avenue and the work will take place in front of 258 Stribling Avenue. The purpose of this shutdown is to install two tees and an inline valve necessary for the Wholesale Metering Program.

Due to a delay in the arrival of materials, the work has been rescheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on **Tuesday, June 27, 2017**, and we anticipate that your water service will be restored by 4:30 p.m. However, should unforeseen problems arise, the disruption could be for a longer period of time. We encourage you to store water ahead of time and turn off your hot water heater to prevent damage, should it drain. If weather causes any issues with the work, the temporary shutdown will be rescheduled for Wednesday, June 28, 2017 during the same time period.

Any time your water service is disrupted, you may experience air in the line and discoloration of water. Should this occur, running the water for a short period of time normally clears the problem fairly quickly. Personnel will be in the area to flush the main line as we put it back in service to try and minimize these effects. We regret the inconvenience you will experience and we appreciate your cooperation as we make the improvements to the water system.
