BOIL WATER OR BOTTLE USE ADVISORY **LIFTED** RT. 29 NORTH NEAR AIRPORT ROAD

December 26, 2025 - Charlottesville, Virginia — Due to a water main break along Route 29 near the North Fork Rivanna River, low pressure occurred in the water system. As a precaution, the following Albemarle County Service Authority customers were advised to boil all tap water used for drinking and cooking or alternatively use bottled water. Areas covered by the advisory included:



The Albemarle County Service Authority is pleased to report that water service has been fully restored and subsequent water quality testing shows the water quality to be safe. **THE BOIL WATER ADVISORY IS LIFTED**, and it is no longer necessary to boil your water before using. The following measures are strongly encouraged at this time:

- Empty and clean your automatic ice makers and water chillers.
- Service connections with a water softener/cartridge filter should be run through a regeneration cycle or other procedures recommended by the manufacturer.
